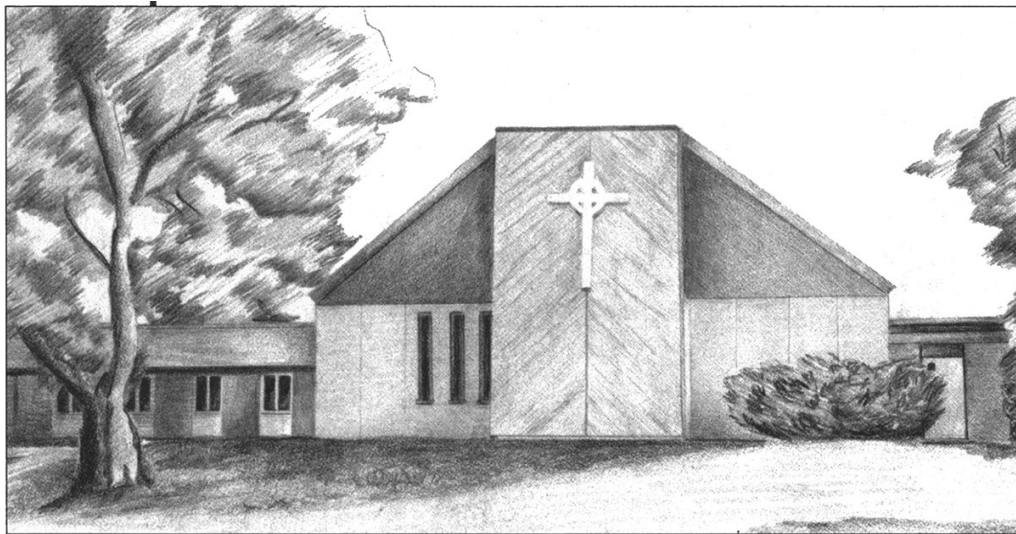

All because we do not carry everything to God in prayer!

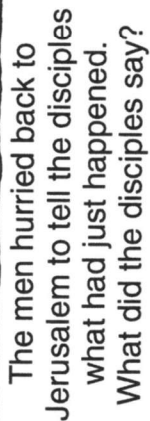
### SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

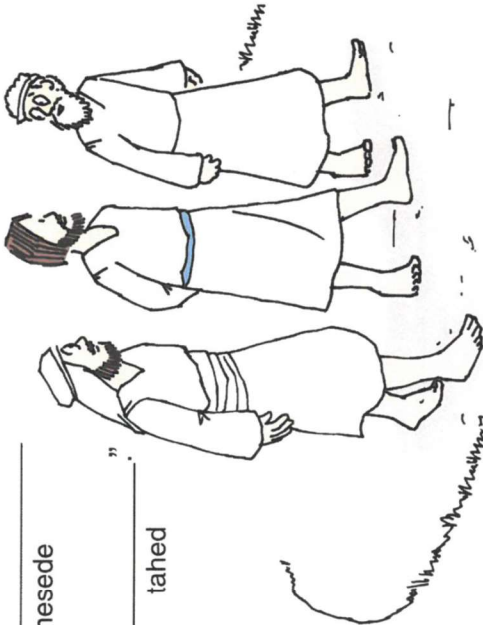

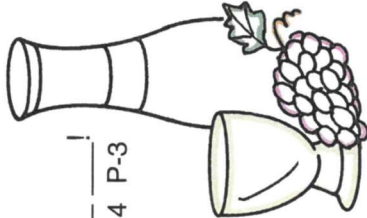
