#### **Pastor Scott's Scripts**

Dear Family and Friends of North Church,

On Sunday July 5<sup>th</sup>, North Presbyterian Church will resume in-person worship. Our plan is to worship outside on our back lawn at 8:00am and 10:00am. Throughout the Summer, worshiping outside will give us the safest option to meet together during the Covid-19 Pandemic.

The following is a list of guidelines that will be expected when we are worshiping together outside:

- 1. Thou shalt not hug.
- 2. Thou Shalt not shake hands (elbow bumping will be allowed).
- 3. Thou shall sit at least 6 feet from people outside your immediate family (families are allowed to sit together).
- 4. There will be no congregational Hymn singing. The organist/pianist will play our Hymns for us to enjoy.
- 5. Wearing a fabric face covering is strongly recommended. While encouraged to bring your own masks, there will be a limited supply available for our outdoor services.
- 6. The offering plate will not be passed. An offering box will be available for you to show your support of our church.
- 7. Our lawn is big, really big! Please spread out and practice social distancing between you and others. Our intent is to provide as safe of an environment for worship as possible, as we want everyone to remain healthy. Part of our health includes Spiritual Health, which we are working towards providing.
- 8. Please bring your own lawn chairs if possible. Folding chairs will be available but will need to be sanitized between services. If you can bring your own chairs it lessens contamination possibilities.
- 9. There will be no fellowship time after service.
- 10. On July 5<sup>th</sup> we will be celebrating the Sacrament of Holy Communion. The congregation is invited to bring their own elements. Pre-Packaged elements will be available as well.
- 11. Worship Service is based on weather permitting. If there is inclement weather, we will only have on-line services. We will NOT be worshiping indoors at the church.
- 12. I will **NOT** be available to shake hands following the service.

It has been a long 3 1/2 months since we have been able to worship in person. I'm looking forward to seeing you again! I do want to emphasize that we will be continuing our on-line worship service. Please do not feel compelled to come to In-person worship service. Protect yourself and do what is best for you. I will absolutely understand there are those who are not ready to attend in-person worship, this is a NO GUILT ZONE!

Thank you so much for your patience, your understanding, your generous support, and for your love and commitment to your church!!!


